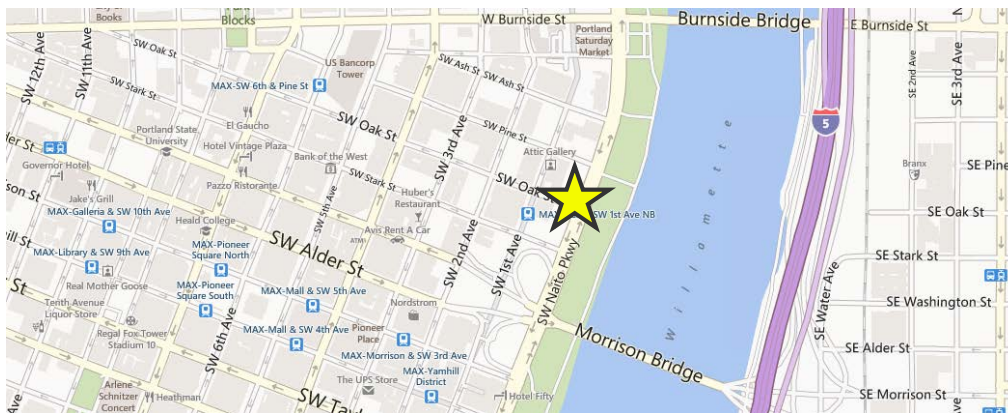




PORTLAND'S OLDEST BUILDING TO BE FULLY RESTORED by John Russell

BUILDING FEATURES

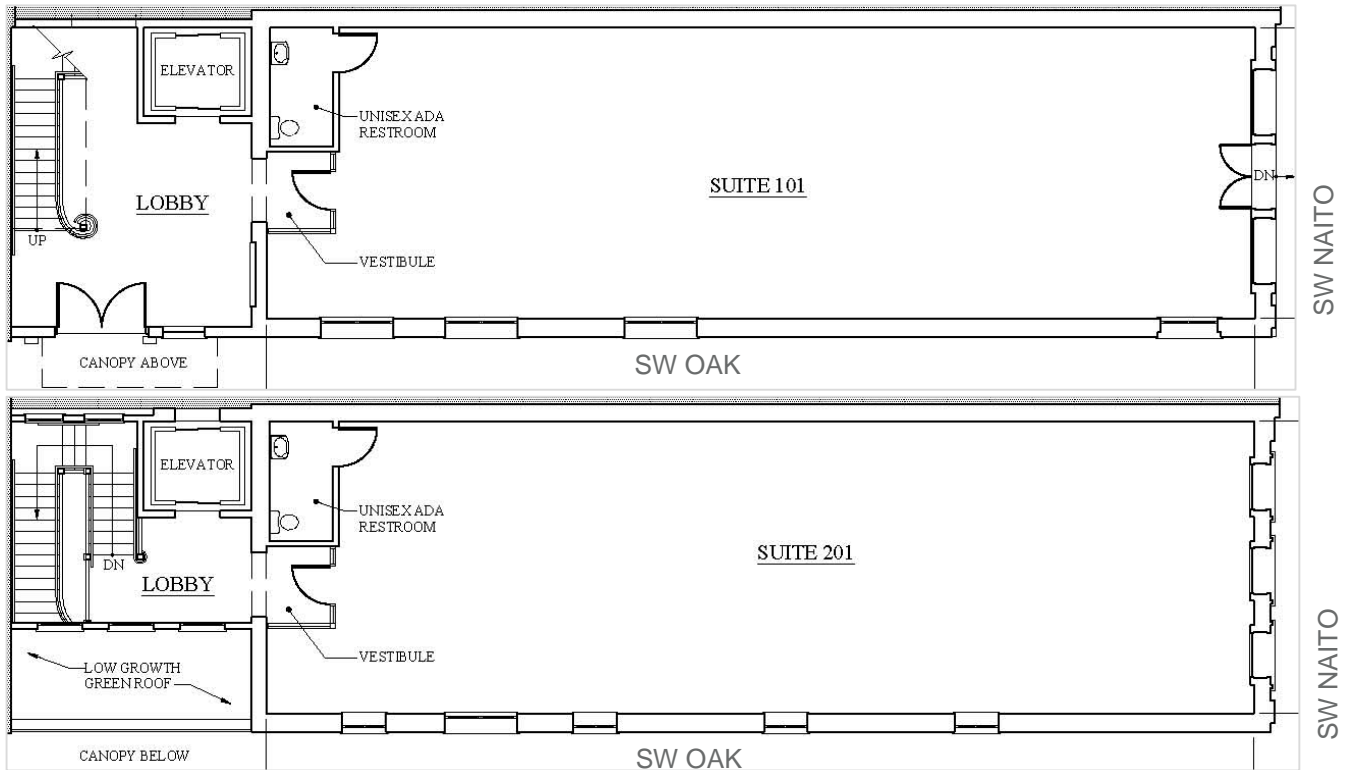
- Built in 1857

The Hallock & McMillan building, as it was first known, is downtown **Portland's first brick commercial structure**, according to records kept by the Architectural Heritage Center. The building was erected two years before Oregon became a state and only six years after Portland was incorporated as a city.
